This month I am pleased to be able to report that 2 individuals have recently been charged with burglaries in the Breckland North area. One had targeted properties in Swaffham and following enquires was quickly arrested and remains behind bars on remand to be brought before the Courts later in November. The second individual was arrested following enquiries in to the series of rural burglaries across our rural areas. Again, this person has been charged to Court later this month. It was a pleasure to attend the Mayor of Dereham's annual Civic Service and reception in October and to speak to some of the many people, paid and voluntary, who work hard to keep our communities safer places to live.

My SNT have been out and about over the Halloween and Bonfire Night period ensuring that any anti-social behaviour reported was dealt with quickly and proportionately.

Finally, with the nights getting darker earlier at this time of year, it's also a good opportunity to remind residents to complete the Social Media #9pm Routine campaign – to check before bed that your doors, windows and vehicles are locked and secured.

## What is Happening In Your Area

October has been a busy month. We are pleased to be able to update you that a 40 year old Dereham man received a 18 week prison sentence following his being arrested and charged with several incidents of shoplifting. Officers from our Special Constabulary have been carrying out ASB patrols and speeding enforcement in the Dereham Town Centre and Mileham, Toftwood and Shipdham areas while your Safer Neighbourhood Team have enjoyed the opportunity to meet with the community at events including The Northgate Remembrance Service, the Mayor's Civic Reception and a Careers Seminar at Northgate High School. Our Dereham Police Cadets have also been very active, taking part in ASB patrols in Dereham and of course attending, along with the Safer Neighbourhood Team, at this years very poignant Remembrance Parade. ## Crime Update—October 2018

(More Statistical Data including Offences & Location Detail can be Obtained from [www.police.co.uk](http://www.police.co.uk))

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	0	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary Residential	1	Residential Burglary will encompass entry to any building within the curtilage/boundary of a residence, e.g. garden sheds and garages
Burglary Business and Community	2	Business and community Burglaries will include shops, businesses and other property. In general, the purpose for which a building is designed will determine whether it should be classified as 'Residential' or 'Business and Community'.
Criminal Damage	1	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	1	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	0	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	1	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	0	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	0	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress		Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	0	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	1	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen from a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.
